

Rebelz Basketball Club Incorporated Player Code of Conduct Policy

1. Purpose

The purpose of this **Player Code of Conduct** is to ensure all junior players of Rebelz Basketball Club uphold respectful, fair, and sportsmanlike behaviour. This policy aligns with Basketball Victoria's Codes of Conduct and promotes a safe, enjoyable environment for all participants.

2. Scope

This policy applies to all registered junior players representing Rebelz Basketball Club in training, games, tournaments, and club events, both on and off the court.

3. Code of Conduct

All players must:

Respect and Responsibility

Show respect to coaches, referees, court supervisors, opponents, spectators, and teammates at all times.

Accept decisions by officials without dispute or argument.

Play by the rules and spirit of the game.

Respect the rights, dignity, and worth of all participants regardless of gender, ability, cultural background, or religion.

Positive Attitude and Effort

Give 100% effort in training and games.

Encourage and support teammates.

Remain positive and resilient, whether winning or losing.

Use encouraging language – no swearing, taunting, sledging, or negative behaviour.

Safety and Wellbeing

Play in a safe manner, avoiding dangerous or reckless actions.

Report any injuries, unsafe conditions, or inappropriate behaviour to a coach or team manager.

Wear appropriate uniform and safety equipment (e.g., mouthguards) during games.



Club Representation

Act as an ambassador for the Rebelz Basketball Club.
Follow the directions of coaching staff and club officials at all times.
Represent the club with pride and integrity during all basketball-related activities.

Social Media and Online Conduct

Do not post or share inappropriate, offensive, or negative content related to basketball, teammates, opponents, officials, or the club.
Use social media respectfully and in line with the Club's Social Media Policy.

4. Breaches of the Code of Conduct

Breaches of this policy will be addressed in accordance with the Club's disciplinary procedures and may result in: **NOTE: Please also Refer to Section 11 of the Rebelz Basketball Club Incorporated Constitution.**

A verbal or written warning
Temporary suspension from training or games
Meeting with parents/guardians and club officials
Expulsion from the team or club for serious or repeated violations
