

Rebelz Basketball Club Incorporated Privacy Policy

1. Purpose

Rebelz Basketball Club (the “Club”) is committed to protecting the privacy and personal information of our players, parents/guardians, volunteers, and members. This Privacy Policy outlines how we collect, use, store, and disclose personal information in accordance with the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth) and the Australian Privacy Principles (APPs).

2. What Information We Collect

We may collect personal and sensitive information including but not limited to:

- Player and parent/guardian names, addresses, emails, and phone numbers
- Date of birth and personal identification information
- Medical information and emergency contacts
- Photographs and videos taken during club activities
- Club registration details and team allocations
- Working With Children Checks (WWCC) for volunteers and coaches

3. How We Collect Information

We collect information via:

- Registration forms (online or paper)
- Email or phone correspondence
- Club events, training sessions, and games
- Photography and video recordings



- Third-party systems (e.g., PlayHQ)

We only collect information directly from individuals or their authorised representatives unless otherwise permitted by law.

4. Why We Collect Information

We collect, use and store personal information for purposes such as:

- Registering players with the Club and competition organisers
- Organising training, games, and team allocations
- Communicating with members about Club activities
- Managing emergencies and player safety
- Promoting the Club through photos, videos, and news updates
- Meeting legal and child safety obligations

5. Storage and Security

We take reasonable steps to protect personal information from misuse, loss, unauthorised access, modification, or disclosure. Information is securely stored electronically and/or in locked physical storage, and only authorised personnel have access.

6. Use and Disclosure

We may share personal information with:

- Basketball Victoria, associations, or league organisers
- Medical personnel in case of emergency
- Photographers and media for promotional purposes (with consent)
- Government bodies if legally required

We will not sell or rent your personal information to third parties.



7. Photography and Media

Photos or videos taken during games, training, and Club events may be used for Club promotions (e.g. website, social media, newsletters). Consent is obtained during the registration process. Individuals may request to opt-out at any time.

8. Access and Correction

You may request access to, or correction of, your personal information held by the Club. Requests can be made in writing to:

9. Data Retention

We retain personal information only for as long as necessary for the purposes stated or as required by law. Unneeded personal information is securely destroyed or de-identified.

10. Complaints

If you believe your privacy has been breached, please contact the Club. We will respond promptly and in accordance with the Australian Privacy Principles. If you are not satisfied with our response, you may contact the Office of the Australian Information Commissioner (OAIC).

11. Changes to This Policy

We may update this Privacy Policy from time to time. The most current version will always be available on our Club's website and distributed via official communications.
